

# **BEST PRACTICES**Sample Member Survey about Programming

One way to help ensure your Chapter's programming is meeting the expectations of your Members is to ask them! Consider sending out a short survey through a free platform like <u>SurveyMonkey</u> to learn more about what your Members are interested in, which issues they care about, and what types of events and activities they want to see. Below are a few sample questions to get you started. This sample survey is drafted in such a way that it would be best to send it out to members at the start of a new Chapter year, but the questions could be modified based on when you would like to get feedback from your Chapter.

## 1. What skills, if any, would you like to gain through Net Impact programming and training? Select your top two choices:

(\*This list is not exhaustive. Choose 4-5 options that are most relevant to your Chapter.)

- Design thinking (understanding user needs, generating solutions, prototyping to test)
- Business planning (writing a plan, business model canvas)
- Career Development (resumes, professional networking, job applications)
- Collaboration (consensus building, interdisciplinary teams, virtual collaboration tools and approaches)
- Communication (storytelling, network building)
- Creativity/innovation (design thinking, entrepreneurship, adaptive thinking)
